



2016-2017 Uniform Standards

Texas Preparatory School will follow the uniform standards outlined in the table below. These uniform standards will be strictly enforced throughout the year. Students will be allowed to have free dress on Fridays *if* they meet the requirements, which are detailed below.

UNIFORM/DRESS CODE POLICY



- All clothing must fit appropriately—not too loose or too tight.
- All clothing must be clean and unsoiled.
- All clothing must be in good condition—free of holes, tears, and stains.
- Hats, hoods, and bandanas are not to be worn in buildings, Monday-Friday (only allowed on assigned, special days).
- Items worn, including jewelry, should not be considered a distraction to learning.*
- Hair should be of a natural color. Distracting hair styles may not be worn. *

Administrator reserves the right to determine what is considered distracting.

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

Uniform violations are considered a disciplinary issue and will be handled weekly as follows:

1st Violation: Written notification will be issued to be signed by parent and returned; loss of free dress.

2nd Violation: Written notification will be issued & parent phone call made; recess detention.

3rd Violation: Discipline referral will be issued & parent phone call made; In School Suspension.

FREE DRESS FRIDAYS

Students will have the opportunity to earn free dress on Friday of each week if they meet the following standards during the week (Friday of the current week to Thursday of the next week):

- NO Dress Code Violations
- NO Unexcused Absences (3 tardies during the week will equal 1 unexcused absence)
- Homework Completed and Submitted
- Acceptable Behavior
 - Primary (K-2): No more than 1 color change for the week
 - Intermediate & 6th Grade: No more than 2 checks for the week

If a student earns free dress, he or she may wear regular street clothes, following these guidelines:

- Clothing should not be offensive or disrupt the learning environment.
- Clothing should be neat, fit appropriately, and shirts must cover the abdomen.
- Shorts, skirts, and any slits in such attire may not be higher than the tip of the student's longest finger.



- No flip-flops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, or hats may be worn.

Student's transfer may be revoked if uniform violations are ongoing.
