

Texas Preparatory Schools will follow the uniform standards outlined in the table below. These uniform standards will be strictly enforced throughout the year. Students will be allowed to have free dress on Fridays *if* they meet the requirements, which are detailed below.

UNIFORM/DRESS CODE POLICY

- All clothing must fit appropriately—not too loose or too tight.
- All clothing must be clean and unsoiled.
- All clothing must be in good condition—free of holes, tears, and stains.
- Hats, hoods, sunglasses, and bandanas are not to be worn in buildings, Monday-Friday (only allowed on assigned, special days).
- Items worn, including jewelry, should not be considered a distraction to learning.*

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

Uniform violations are considered a disciplinary issue, and teachers will deduct points on Class DOJO, which will affect students' ability to earn free dress on Friday. Should a student come to school in free dress when it is not earned, parents/guardians will be called for a change of clothes. If a uniform is not provided, the student will automatically lose free dress for two weeks. A student's transfer may be revoked if uniform violations are ongoing.

FREE DRESS FRIDAYS

Students will have the opportunity to earn free dress on Friday of each week if they earn a 90% or above on Class DOJO during the week (Friday of the current week to Thursday of the next week). Parents will be provided details on how points are earned and deducted on Class DOJO.

If a student earns free dress, he or she may wear regular street clothes, following these guidelines:

Clothing should not be offensive or disrupt the learning environment.
Clothing should be neat, fit appropriately, and shirts must cover the abdomen.
Shorts, skirts, and any slits in such attire may not be higher than the tip of the student's longest finger.
No flip-flops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, pajamas, or hats may be worn.
Masks of choice must be worn.
